Break Away is in a transitional phase in our life as an organization as we explore potential changes for our future. Possible paths include merging with or being absorbed by another nonprofit organization, seeking financial sponsorship, becoming a program of a college/university, or maintaining our status quo. Additionally, the board will be focused on collective fundraising efforts to increase revenue streams. We are seeking Board Members that aim to be actively engaged in this unique time and are excited about the possibility of using their skills and experiences to guide the organization in a strategic direction.

Board Responsibilities: The Break Away Board of Directors is responsible for the direction, oversight and resources of the organization. As a group, we ensure the organization remains committed to our mission, set policies for the health of the organization, and support financial health.

Each Board Member commits to:

- Serve as an ambassador of Break Away by communicating the organization's work and values to the community and their networks
- Stay informed about the work of the organization
- Make a personal contribution to Break Away each year and contribute or raise at least \$1,000 annually
 - Please note that Break Away has a sliding equity scale and a new strategy for total board contributions in development so that financial contribution is not a barrier to board membership for any person. We encourage you to still apply even if the \$1000 give/get may not be a contribution you can make.
- Participate in fundraising on behalf of the organization throughout the entire year, including campaigns like Giving Tuesday
- Dedicate approximately 5-7 hours/month to Break Away Board activities
- Maintain active participation and leadership on Board, including leading WIN
 Teams/Committees, serving as a Board Officer, volunteering for tasks, offer connections, etc.
- Attend and actively participate in monthly virtual meetings, including 1 in-person meeting during each two year term (Board members cover their own travel expenses)
- Regularly reflect and assess their own participation and contributions
